COVID-19 has heightened career uncertainty in a work landscape dominated by turbulence and change, and it is directly impacting how people are entering—or reentering—the workplace. But as *New York Times* bestselling author and career and workplace expert **Lindsey Pollak** makes clear, the pandemic merely accelerated career and hiring trends that have been building. Job seekers of all generations and skill sets must learn how to adapt to this “new normal,” which includes: 1) a hybrid of remote and in-person experiences; 2) increased reliance on virtual communication and automation; 3) constant disruption; 4) renewed employer emphasis on diversity, equity, and inclusion; and 5) expansion of the “gig” economy and alternative employment options.

Ms. Pollak is a *New York Times* bestselling author and one of the world's leading career and workplace experts. She was named to the 2020 Thinkers50 Radar List, which honors the top global management thinkers whose work is shaping the future of how organizations are managed and led. Ms. Pollak's other books include *The Remix: How to Lead and Succeed in the Multigenerational Workplace*; *Becoming the Boss: New Rules for the Next Generation of Leaders*; and *Getting from College to Career: Your Essential Guide to Succeeding in the Real World*. Her speaking audiences and consulting clients have included more than 250 corporations, law firms, conferences, and universities.
