She is a career artist practicing throughout greater Chicagoland, and has exhibited both nationally and internationally for over 30 years. In 2021, Kedem-DuBose was nominated for the prestigious 3Arts Award, and her work was added to the collection of Chicago's Field Museum of Natural History's 2020 Covid Collection.
